- 2009: Governor Schwarzenegger issues Executive Order S-21-09 2011:
- 2011: Senate Bill X1-2, signed by Gov. Edmund G. Brown, Jr., codifies 33% by 2020 RPS.

Why Audubon California?

Lessons learned on wind energy in California - Altamont



6 years & \$600,000

 Litigation and settlement cost Citizens for Clean Renewable Energy and 5 Chapters of Audubon over 6 years and \$600,000 in resources to achieve reduction in mortality.



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


Figure 1.1. All bird fatalities per nameplate MW per year at North American facilities with published fatality data.



- Reduced Cut-in speed may help bats






